Dear Penn National Golf Member,

On behalf of Penn National Golf Club and our tournament committee members Dan Whaley, Bob Ferris, Roy Kratz, Barry Pitasky, and Dick Young we would like to invite you to play in the 15th Annual Penn National Golf Club Member Guest Golf Tournament.

In response to our annual participant feedback and committee critique we will keep the new format changes we added to the tournament activities last year and tweak some existing items to make them even more fun and exciting.

- o Rebekah & Kirk Crouse of Merrill Lynch-Chambersburg, will once again graciously sponsor our Tuesday evening activities.

- o Members will continue being able to play the tees with which they have established their handicap. (See specific details below.)

- o We again will offer a "flighted" putting contest (optional) to create more winners Tuesday evening.

- o A "Guest" needs to be a male non-member with an established handicap at another facility other than Penn National. A "Guest" cannot play regularly at Penn National.

- o There will be four flights and therefore eight winner payouts that will once again be increased substantially this year.

- o The Overall Tournament Champions will receive a suitable additional prize commemorating their excellent performance during our event.

The tournament will be held on Tuesday, June 26th and Wednesday, June 27th 2018. The Tournament Schedule and Member Guest Entry Form are enclosed. Tournament registration is limited to the first 16 paid team entries by May 25, 2018.

Please put these dates on your calendar. Please return your entry form and check to the Pro Shop before our list is full. **We also urge you to contact your guest today, get their commitment to participate.** Entries after the first 16 will be held on a waiting list should there be a cancellation or will be accepted in groups of 4, with a cap of 20 teams.

The food is provided by Altland House who manages the Founder's Grille. (Wine will be served at our banquet dinner Wednesday evening.) You and your guest will also receive logoed golf shirts commemorating this year's tournament.

Tournament Play: There will be four to five flights of four teams each. The golf event will be 36 holes with 27 holes of match play and 9 holes of medal play. The match play rounds will consist of 3 different 9-hole matches. A point scoring system will be used to determine flight winners. On Tuesday, play will be on the Iron Forge course and on Wednesday, play will be on the Founders course. After the flight winners are determined, there will be a shootout style playoff to decide the overall Champions.

The shootout will be held on the Founders Course. Of the 16 teams, Flights 1-2 will compete on Founders Hole #2 and Flights 3-4(5) will compete on Hole #1. The shootout will continue on Hole #4, Hole #5 and Hole #6 if necessary to decide the championship. We will assign your tee selection based on where you post a majority of your scores. For guests, we will assign tee based on the yardage where they post a majority of their scores.

It will be a wonderful event and we urge you to sign up today.
