Dear Penn National Golf Member,

On behalf of Penn National Golf Club and tournament committee: Dan Whaley - Chair, Lee Grimm, Rollie Jacobs, Jim Leaman, Barry Pitasky and Dick Young, we invite you to play in the 22nd Annual Penn National Golf Club Men's Member Guest Golf Tournament.

The tournament will be held on Tuesday, June 24th & Wednesday, June 25th 2025. The Tournament Schedule and Member Guest Entry Form are enclosed. Tournament registration is limited to the first 24 paid team entries by June 1st, 2025. We reserve the opportunity to expand to 28 teams if we obtain that level of interest. We urge you to contact your guest today and get their commitment to participate. Then please return your entry form and check to the Pro Shop ASAP.

The Men's Member Guest is a two-day event. The following will be included in this year's tournament:

- 3 9-hole matches & 1 9-hole stroke play match
- Putting Contest and picnic dinner Tuesday evening
- Optional Skins Pool (separate \$50 entry fee paid at registration)
- Awards Reception Party immediately after Wednesday's 1:30 pm Championship shoot-out

Members will play the tees with which they have established their handicap. A "Guest" needs to be a male non-member with an established handicap at another facility other than Penn National. A "Guest" cannot play regularly at Penn National. If your Guest does not have an established handicap see Darin to discuss a remedy. (Maximum Handicap will be 36 for any player.)

The food will be provided by Altland House who manages the Founders Grille. We will have a box lunch at the turn on Tuesday and picnic dinner with putting contest following golf. Wednesday morning, coffee, juice and donuts will be provided. **Immediately following** Wednesday's Championship shoot-out we will meet in the Founders Grille to celebrate the winners, distribute awards and enjoy four heavy Hors D'oeuvres Stations. You and your guest will receive 3 adult beverage tickets each to be used at Tuesday evening's picnic and another 3 tickets for Wednesday afternoon's awards meal. Any additional adult beverages will be on a cash basis on your own. If you bring your own wine the corkage fee will be waived. Bottled water will be available on the course during play.

<u>Tournament Play</u>: There will be six flights of four teams each. The golf event will be 36 holes with 27 holes of match play and 9 holes of medal play. The match play rounds will consist of 3 different 9-hole matches. A point scoring system will be used to determine flight winners. On Tuesday, play will be on the Iron Forge course and on Wednesday, play will be on the Founders Course. After the flight winners are determined, there will be a shoot-out style playoff to decide the overall Champions.

The shoot-out will be held on the Founders Course. Of the 24 teams, Flights 1-3 will compete on Founders Hole #2 and Flights 4-6 will compete on Hole #1. The shootout will continue on Hole #4, Hole #5 and Hole #6 if necessary, to decide the championship. We will assign your tee selection based on where you post a majority of your scores. For guests, we will assign tee based on the yardage where they post a majority of their scores.

It will be a wonderful event and we urge you to sign up today.
