For golf handicap purposes, the active golf season ended at Penn National and other Pennsylvania golf courses on October 31, 2012. The active golf season is defined by the controlling golf association which for Penn National and many other Pennsylvania golf courses is Keystone's Premier Golf Association. While scores may be entered during our inactive golf season, these scores will only affect the player's handicap if the course played is considered 'in season'.

For other locations, the controlling golf association determines the active golf season. In most southern states, the golf season is always active.

How do you know whether the course you are playing is in season or inactive? Either ask the golf professional at the course or look it up on the web. The USGA provides a summary by state here: <http://www.usga.org/Content.aspx?id=25489>
